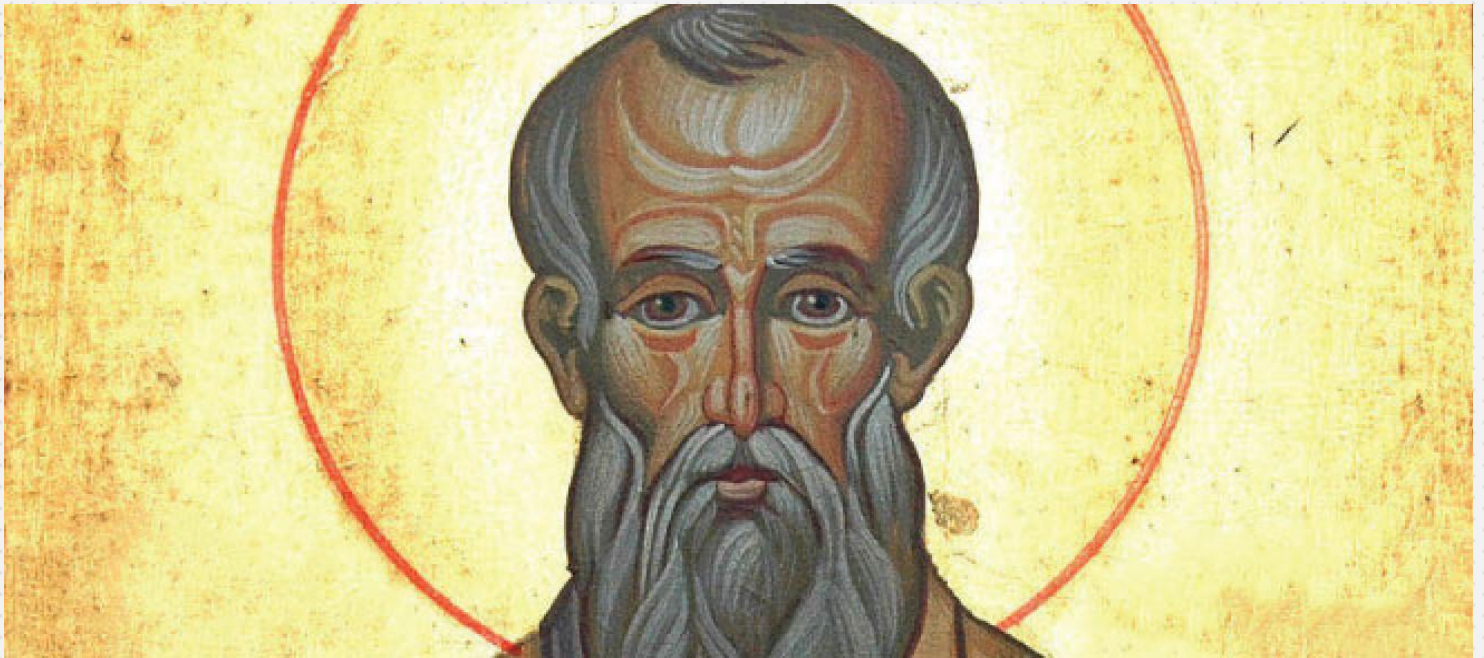


# St Athanasius Seminar 2019
